Country of medieval castles, beautiful landscapes, magnificent churches and 1,000 years of Christianity, Poland is a unique spiritual experience for those, who wish to see a country that is still vibrantly Catholic. This pilgrimage will take you to many beautiful churches, shrines, miraculous images, as well as places connected with one of history's greatest popes. One of the highlights will be the Royal City of Krakow, which was once known as the "Rome of the North." Each day of the pilgrimage includes the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in one of many historic churches.

TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 7. Departure from Chicago O'Hare airport.

WEDNESDAY. Arrival in Krakow. After check in at our hotel we will begin our pilgrimage with Mass followed by an orientation tour of the city. Overnight in Krakow.

THURSDAY. Following Mass in one of Krakow's historic churches, we will tour the highlights of the medieval Old City, including Wawel Cathedral.

FRIDAY. Travel to the famous Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa, the spiritual heart of Poland & third largest Marian shrine in Europe. On the way, we will visit the shrine of the Holy Sepulcher in Miechow. Overnight in Czestochowa.

SATURDAY. Mass at the altar of the Miraculous Icon, believed to be painted by St. Luke the Evangelist, on a portion of the Holy Family's table from Nazareth. Time for prayer and private devotions. Overnight in Czestochowa.

SUNDAY. Depart for Krakow. Enroute we will visit the castle at Olsztyn. Overnight in Krakow.

MONDAY. After Mass one can choose optional tours to the Concentration Camp at Auschwitz and the Wieliczka Salt Mine or further explore the many beautiful churches and sites of Krakow.

TUESDAY. Travel to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, the second largest Marian shrine in Poland, where Pope John Paul II, as a once frequent pilgrim cultivated his deep devotion to the Blessed Virgin, for Mass in the shrine's basilica. Then on to Zakopane in the heart of Poland's Tatry Mountains.

WEDNESDAY. This morning we will enjoy the beautiful mountain village of Zakopane. On the way back to Krakow, stop for dinner in Nowy Targ. Overnight in Krakow.

THURSDAY. Mass at the tomb of St. John Cantius in the beautiful 18th century Church of St. Anne. Following Mass, more time for exploring the many riches of Krakow's Old City, as well as free time for shopping or a quiet afternoon in one of the city's quaint cafes.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 17. After Mass at the Basilica of The Blessed Virgin Mary on Krakow's Main Square, there is free time for more shopping before departing to the Krakow-Balice airport for the trip home.
